



## FSAA—Performance Task Spring 2017 Late Reporting

Dear Alternate Assessment Coordinator/District Assessment Coordinator,

The purpose of this email is to inform you of the late reporting release for the Spring 2017 Florida Standards Alternate Assessment—Performance Task (FSAA—PT).

Students included in this release are those whose assessments were submitted during the extended submission period or those that were impacted by an approved formal appeals response. To find out if your district is expected to receive updated reports, please reference your district's FTP under the Late Reporting folder for specific student information. If your district is not expected to receive updates, your district's FTP will not have a Late Reporting folder. As a reminder, your district's login credentials to the FSAA Student Reporting System is provided in an excel file posted to the district FTP. Also available in the excel file is a master list of the login credentials for all the schools in your district.

If your district has students included in late reporting, the following school and district reports will be updated and provided:

- Individual Student Reports (impacted students only)
- District level Student Test Results Data File
- District level Assessed Summary Data File
- School level Student Roster Report

Reports will be accessible on **November 2, 2017 at 9:00 am EST**, via the FSAA Student Reporting System located at: <http://iservices.measuredprogress.org>. Please follow instructions previously provided to access and download test results.

In addition to the online reports, one color hard copy of the student report will be shipped via UPS ground delivery to district AAC offices on November 14, 2017. As with the first reporting release, each school's reports will be individually packaged and clearly labeled for easy distribution.
