- The conclusion of Collection Period #3 is **April 6, 2018**.
- The deadline to submit evidence files in the AVS is **April 13, 2018**.

This is the final collection period for the 2017–18 FSAA—Datafolio Administration.

One *Ethics in Data Collection and Submission* form must be submitted in the AVS for each student that participated in the FSAA—Datafolio. If digital recording evidence is being submitted for any student, a *Digital Recording Consent Form*, signed by the parent, must also be submitted for all students visible in the recording.
