



FSAA Spring 2018 Initial Results Re-Release Information

Due to unanticipated issues, some student results that should have appeared in the June 8, 2018 Initial (online and CSV files) Report Release of results from the 2018 FSAA Performance Task* did not. A **re-release** is now available on the FSAA Student Results System at <https://iservices.measuredprogress.org>. Please note that the files are inclusive of **all** data and student score reports for the Spring 2018 assessment, including those students whose assessments were submitted after the window closed. The purpose of this email is to provide you with the information and resources necessary to access these results. There were no changes to the 2018 FSAA-Datafolio data files.

***To have students who did not appear in the June 8 data files be included in school grades calculations, districts must submit an appeal to the FLDOE Accountability, Research & Measurement Office via your district's primary accountability coordinator.**

What is Available?

FSAA Performance Task

Revised Initial Report Release: Districts are now able to access the password-protected site to view and download the following reports:

- **Student Test Results Data File:** data will include basic demographic information, test participation status, item set scores, task level complexity and student accuracy scores, scale score, and achievement level for each student within the district detailed by school. This will be provided as a CSV file.
 - **Student Test Results Data File Layout:** layout will include a description of each field.
- **Assessed Summary Data File:** data will include number of students *Tested*, number of students *Not Tested*, number and percentage of students in each achievement level, by grade and content area within the district detailed by school. This will be provided as a CSV file.
 - **Assessed Summary Data File Layout:** layout will include a description of each field.
- **Student Report:** for each academic area assessed, your student will be provided with performance information at each level of complexity (Task 1 level, Task 2 level, and Task 3 level). Your student will receive an overall academic area scale score and achievement level. Additional detail about the level that the student achieved and the student's achievement over time, when applicable, is provided. In addition, information about your students' performance compared to other students in their school, district, and state that participated in the FSAA is provided.
- **Student Roster Report:** for each academic area, your school will be provided with a roster style report that captures your students' individual performances, including *Participation Codes* as applicable.

Your district user name and password to the FSAA Student Reporting System is provided in an excel file posted to the district FTP folder. This is the same FTP folder districts have been using throughout the year for FSAA data exchanges with Measured Progress. Also available in the excel file is a master list of the username and password for all the schools in your district.

Measured Progress shipped to you memos, in May, for each school within your district that participated in the FSAA— Performance Task or FSAA Datafolio. The memos, addressed to the principal, include general information and instructions, and school specific user name and password credentials to access school level reports through the FSAA Student Reporting System. You (AAC) are responsible for the dissemination of these memos.

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

FERPA requires that access to individual student results, including those provided in the FSAA Performance Task and FSAA Datafolio, be restricted to the student, the student's parents/guardians, and authorized school personnel. In accordance with this federal regulation, authorized school personnel shall have access to the records of students to whom they are providing services when such access is required in the performance of their official duties. **For more information about FERPA please visit the following website:**
